OPEN Provincial Qualifying OMFA Classical Piano Class

Two (2) contrasting classical piano selections must be performed from a program of **three (3)** classical piano selections in total at the ARCT level or above. The program must be submitted in its entirety when entering and should be musically contrasting. Competitors may count one or more movements of a multi-movement work as one selection only. If one selection is a sonata, at least two consecutive movements (a minuet and a trio is considered one movement) must be performed. Concert etudes are permitted at this level, however piano concertos are not permitted. Time limit is 40 minutes.
